**Subject: Transfer & Postings in the cadre of newly promoted JCSIT- Order  
No.84 of 2014 - regarding**

Kindly refer to the Transfer and Posting Order No. 70 of 2014 dated 16.05.2014 and No. 84 dated 19.06.2014 in the cadre of the JCSIT. The Association vide letter dated 22.05.2014 has brought to your kind notice that four JCSIT who were eligible for retention in the present place of posting have been ordered to be posted to a new region in Order No. 70 of 2014 in contravention of clause 6.1, 3.3 and 4.6 of the existing TPG 2010. The request / representation of Officers have already been sent to CBDT through proper channel in addition to representation by Association. Despite such facts being brought to your notice, no cognizance of facts has been taken in respect of three officers by CBDT while passing order No. 84 on 19.06.2014 rectifying their earlier order No. 70 dated 16.05.2014.

To mention the cases of those officers who were not covered in order No. 84 on 19.06.2014, Sh Sanjeev Kumar Dev, (04520) and Sh Subhrajyoti Bhattacharjee ( 04532), their child(ren) are studying in class XII in academic year 2014-15 whose cases are covered under clause 6.1 of TPG 2010 while the case of Sh S P Gupta ( 03568) is covered under clause 3.3 and 4.6 as his stay in the present region i.e. Delhi CCA is less than 2 years.

It is, therefore, requested that the above three cases may be sympathetically considered for suitable modification in transfer orders.
