Respected Sir,

Sub: One time relaxation for the compassionate appointment - Request regarding.

We solicit your kind reference to the discussions on 31st March, 2016. One of the issues that we brought to your kind notice was the large number of pending applications for appointment of the dependents of our employees who died in harness. This pendency is created due to the ceiling of 5% of Direct Recruitments on all compassionate appointments as introduced by the Department of Personnel and Training. The DoPT further decided that those candidates who could not be offered the appointment for want of vacancies (i.e. within the 5% ceiling) must be kept pending only for 3 years and thereafter removed from the list, which was later quashed by the highest Judiciary in the Country. The revised order issued by the DoPT is also ambiguous.

During our discussions, we pleaded that at least a onetime relaxation of the ceiling of 5% is needed to consider the cases which are fit for compassionate appointments. You had been good enough to consider our request and to direct the concerned officers to do the needful in the matter. In order to know the gravity of the situation, the data concerning pending applications, the recommendations of the screening committee, number of vacancies in each charge etc. ought to have been collected and collated by now. However, no communication from the CBDT, till the writing of this letter, has been issued in deference to your decision, to elicit such data.

As per our information, about 1485 such applications are pending at various Pr.CCSIT charges, details of which are given in the enclosed annexure.

We hope that your kind intervention will definitely bring a ray of hope for the applicants for compassionate appointment in the Department. We shall be grateful, if the JS (Admn.) CBDT, is directed to collect the requisite information from the Regions/Charges without further loss of time and proceed to obtain such a onetime relaxation from the DoPT.
