The matter has been brought to your kind notice through our letter dated 09-04-2014 and also during verbal discussion we had with you. In all those communication the Board was requested to delay the relieving of officers till the next AGT, 2014. The request was made in view of genuine problems such as children studying in Class X / XII / appearing for Board Examination in the current academic year, physically handicapped officers and spouse ground cases etc. We had also requested for causing a discussion with us on all these cases prior to relieving of the officers. But after the issuance of abovementioned direction we feel that the Board has no sympathetic consideration of the genuine problems of the officers of the Department. All such actions will only adversely affect the moral of the officers, which is not at all in the interest of any organization.

In these circumstances, it is requested once again to retain the officers or to delay their release at least in those cases as mentioned in our letter dated 09-04-2014 till the AGT of 2014 enabling the Board to consider those cases afresh.
