Learned counsel for respondent nos. 1 and 2 has invited this Court's attention to paragraph 2(xv) of the counter affidavit, which depicts that recommendations have been received from a Committee constituted for implementing the judgment rendered by this Court on 27.11.2012, and that based on the above recommendations, a draft tentative seniority list has been prepared and circulated.

It is

further submitted that objections to the above tentative seniority list has since been received from the concerned employees, and that the same would be taken into consideration in preparing the final seniority list in consonance with the judgment dated 27.11.2012. To finalise the seniority list, learned counsel for respondent nos. 1 and 2 seeks four weeks' time.

In view of the explanation tendered by the learned counsel representing respondent nos. 1 and 2, four weeks further time is granted to the respondents to take into consideration the objections filed by the employees concerned, so as to implement the order passed by this Court on 27.11.2012. Needless to mention, that respondent nos. 1 shall be personally responsible, for and 2 ensuring compliance of the undertaking given to this Court, within the time specified.

Contempt petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Mr. P.S. Patwalia, learned senior counsel submits
that the application for intervention filed by his clients
may be dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the applicants
to avail other remedies, in accordance with law.

We order
accordingly.
