Dear Comrades,

Subject: Status as on date of some of the issues being pursued by ITGOA-regarding

The progress made in respect of some major issues pursued by ITGOA, CHQ is as under:

1. (i) **PROMOTION FROM ITO to ACIT**
- (ii) **FINALISATION OF ALL INDIA SENIORITY LIST OF ITOs**
- (iii) **IMPLEMENTATION OF N R PARMAR DECISION**

Regular DPC for promotion of 180 ITOs to ACsIT for R.Y. 2013-14 was convened by UPSC on 2nd & 3rd of September, 2014 along with a review DPC for R.Y. 2012-13. The CHQ is pursuing the Board for issuing the promotion order first and then their placement orders at the earliest. All of our members must be happy for this milestone of promotion of our 180 members which was due for more than 18 months as per DoPT model calendar and proposal for which was pending before UPSC for more than 6 months. However, the bigger task ahead of us is to complete the implementation of NRP decision nationwide in a uniform manner and recast the seniority list of ITOs as fast as possible so that further promotions to the grade of ACIT become possible for the vacancies, both regular and CRC, which are already due.

The CHQ took initiative to impress upon the Board for issuing the uniform Guidelines for implementation of NRP judgement region wise within a short and specified span of time so that the all India seniority of ITOs can be finalised immediately. The issue was raised and demanded from the platform of JCA also. The Hon'ble Chairman, CBDT, too, expressed his view in favour of the opinion of JCA and we may expect the uniform Guidelines be issued by CBDT soon with the direction of completion of the job within a specified time limit.

2. NFSG TO THE JCSIT OF 2001 BATCH

As you are all aware that since March 2014, the CHQ has been pursuing with CBDT for grant of NFSG to left over Promotee Officers of 2001 batch and which in principle was approved by CBDT w.e.f. 01.01.2014. However, the same is still pending and also the deficiency in APARs of so many of our members in that consideration zone still exists. The CHQ finally requested the Board to hold the Screening Committee for NFSG immediately at least for those officers whose APARs are complete and the Board agreed to the proposal. The vigilance clearance is obtained afresh. The proposal for holding the Screening Committee meeting has already been approved by the Chairman. We can expect the NFSG order for our senior members by the end of September itself.

3. T & P orders

Some requests of our members for the T & P orders in the cadres of Addl. CIT/JCIT and DCIT/ACIT have already been accepted and suitable orders have been passed by CBDT. In the cadre of DCIT/ACIT, we have once again represented the details of the left-out officers and the Board has committed to consider the cases of more officers to be transferred back to their home-station and further orders in this cadre is expected soon. In the cadre of Addl. CIT/JCIT, the details are to be submitted again for left out Officers before the Board this week. The Chairman has committed to consider all the similarly placed officers in the transfer orders, the placement committee meeting for which will be convened shortly.

4. Lokpal Act

The Central JCA has already requested to the Chairman, CBDT to impress upon the Competent Authority for extension of the last date of submission of Property Statement by the Govt. Servants. CHQ has also taken up the issue with the JCM(Staff) side to pursue the amendment of certain provisions of the Act to the GOI.

I assure that further development on the above issues and many more issues / demands which the CHQ is seized of, will be intimated immediately to all our members.
